## 1 INTRODUCTION

- Government College of Engineering and Technology (**GCET**), Jammu was established in the year 1994 under the Department of Higher Education, Government of J&K. It is approved by AICTE, New Delhi and affiliated to University of Jammu, Jammu. GCET campus is spread over 869 Kanals of land at village ChakBhalwal, which is 22 Kms away from Jammu. The college was established with the vision to provide valuable resources for industry and society through excellence in technical education and research.
- The college offers Engineering UG degree courses in five disciplines in Electronics and Communication, Electrical, Computer, Mechanical and Civil Engineering with an intake capacity of 60 students in each program. Besides this, the college has started Lateral Entry Scheme in B.E. 3rd Semester with an intake of 10% of the sanctioned intake capacity, supernumerary to the approved intake in each discipline of Engineering from Session 2015 onwards.
- GCET Jammu has become the first institution of UT of J&K to have its three UG programs accredited by **National Board of Accreditation(NBA)** in the year 2019. The programmes which have been accorded accreditation are as under:
  - Computer Engineering,
  - Electronics & Communication Engineering
  - Mechanical Engineering.
- The college is recognized by University Grants Commission under **Section 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act, 1956.**
- The selection of the students for UG program in this college is made through competitive examination conducted by J&K Board Of Professional Entrance Examination(BOPEE) keeping due weightage for SC/ST and other weaker sections as per **J&K reservation rules.**
- So far, students of Twenty five Batches from 1994 to 2019 have passed out from GCET whereas the students of 2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019 batches are presently studying in 8<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Semesters respectively. The Alumni of this Institution have excelled in various spheres and are positioned very well globally in a number of leading Government, Public Sector and Private Organizations at the UT and National level.
- The college is having highly qualified and experienced faculty recruited by open selection through J&K Public Service Commission. The Faculty members of this college are possessing requisite qualifications and experience in accordance with the AICTE norms and are providing

consultancy /engineering solutions to various field agencies from time to time in addition to performing their regular duties as per the academic curriculum. The faculty members are also engaged on an academic arrangement as per the requirement through selection committee headed by Director Colleges and having other panellist/expert members from IIT Jammu and GCET, Jammu.

- GCET Jammu avails **Technical Education Quality Improvement (TEQIP-III)**, a World Bank aided project of MHRD, GOI launched with the objective to upscale and improve the quality and enhance the existing capacities of the participating institutions to become demand driven, quality conscious, efficient and forward looking, responsive to rapid economic and technological developments occurring at National and International level. GCET has constituted Board of Governors( BoG) under TEQIP to monitor the progress of institutional projects on a regular basis and provide the guidance for improving the performance of institution under the Chairmanship of Director IIT, Jammu with eminent academicians and industrialists as members of the BoG.
  - GCET has upgraded the existing lab infrastructure so as to develop the state of the art research facilities for the students/researchers in the field of engineering sciences. Further, to keep abreast with the latest technological happenings and demands of industry, the institute revises syllabus/course on regular basis besides providing opportunity to faculty/staff members and students to attend conferences/seminars/FDP/STC on the emerging areas at different IITS/IIMS etc. To enhance faculty competence, faculty/staff are also being deputed to the leading institutions in a phased manner to upgrade their qualification.
  - Efforts are also being made to explore collaboration of this college with reputed institutions at National / International level/Industry of Repute and Research Centres for providing larger exposure to the students of the UT. In this direction ,the institution has signed a MoU with IIT Jammu for Academic, research collaboration and Technical support for a period of 5 Years.
  - For the welfare of students and staff, other academic and non-academic reforms are also being carried out for improving the learning outcomes from time to time. College conducts various crash courses in the campus for the benefit of the students, appearing in different competitive exams like GATE etc besides conducting workshops/courses on Communication Skills, Group Discussions , Personality Development, Career Counselling and aptitude test by hiring resource persons /experts from Industry & Government Institutions.
- As on date , 1113 students are pursuing their studies in different departments of the Institution.
